Church Services

Thank you very much to all parents and carers that attended our services at St. Andrew's Church, both today and on Wednesday. PTFA Summer Fayre

Thank you to everyone that attended the Summer Fayre last Friday. The total raised was £542.80. We are very grateful to our PTFA for their hard work in planning and organising last Friday's fayre, as well as all other events that have taken place this year – it is very much appreciated!

School Disco

It was lovely to hold our end of term discos on Wednesday evening. The children thoroughly enjoyed both events, particularly the younger children, as we put on our first EYFS/Key Stage 1 version. We managed to raise £477.98 from both events. My thanks to all the staff that stayed to help at both discos.

Open Classrooms

We will be having another Open Classrooms evening on Wednesday 11th September, between 3:40pm and 4:45pm. This will be an opportunity for you to meet your child's new class teacher, ask any questions you may have about routines and to have a look around the classroom. You are welcome to bring your children with you or attend without them. This session will replace the previous Parent Information/Meet and Greet Evenings, allowing parents and carers with more than one child at the school to visit all classrooms on the same evening. The information slides that were previously presented will be running on a loop in the classrooms and will then be uploaded to the website.



School Games Platinum Award

We are delighted to announce that we have achieved the School Games Platinum Award for 2023/24 - 2024/25. This is testament to the work of the staff in school, led by Mrs Pledger, in ensuring that we are offering a wide variety of sporting opportunities for our children. Energy from Waste Award

Continuing on the theme of awards, I am delighted to announce that Year 4 were one of two winners of the Waste Free Lunch Challenge 2024, following on from their visit to the Energy from Waste Centre earlier this year. This is the third time in a row that St. Andrew's children have achieved this award. The class generated only 400g of general waste from their lunch boxes, which was a fantastic effort. Congratulations to Mr Harrison and all of the staff and children in Year 4.

Smartwatches and Mobile Phones

We are in the process of updating our Mobile Phone Policy, which will be published in September. As part of this, the governors have agreed that Smartwatches should not be worn by children in school. This is due to them having the ability to link to the internet and some having cameras, which can cause privacy issues and/or concerns around cyberbullying. A reminder that mobile phones can only be brought into school by children in Years 5 and 6, which must be switched off and stored in the classroom for the duration of the school day.
