CURRICULUM OUTLINE - Our Wonderful World

Winchester: Year 2 Summer Term 2022

English

In English this term, the children will be using the scheme The Write stuff and will be looking at creating their own narrative based on the text 'The Marvellous Fluffy Itsy Bitsy' and the non-chronological report based on 'Big Cats'. The children will experience lessons to gather vocabulary and sentence stacking lessons to embed their understanding on grammatical features and sentence structure.

The children will be using the scheme of Maths No Problem.



Science



In Science this term, the children will be finding out about what plants need to grow well. We will also be learning about different flowers and trees. In class we will be planting seeds, bulbs and cress and then carrying out comparison tests to identify the best growing conditions. After half term, the children will

look at life processes and the needs of humans and other living things in order to stay alive and healthy. They will also study different habitats and how living things depend on each other.

Geography



Our Geography learning will run alongside our Science topic. Whilst finding out about habitats, we will consider where habitats are located, naming towns, countries and continents. We will also consider the features of areas such as coasts, oceans, mountains and forests. Finally, we will combine our scientific and geographical knowledge to discuss areas around our world and how they have

been improved or spoilt and the reasons why.

Computing

ICT will be used to support learning across all areas of the curiculum. The school continues to follow the scheme designed by Purple Mash. The focus this term will be on 'Questionning'. This unit is designed to help children learn about the importance of phrasing questions and that certain data-handling resources are limited in the answers they can provide. In the second half of the term, the focus will be on 'Creating Pictures'. These lessons explore some of the templates and functions of 2Paint a Picture alongside learning about artists and art movements

Art & Design Technology



In Art this term the children will be creating art in response to Eric Carle. They will also be creating moods in art work and think about how the mood of art shows how people feel. The children will use pencils of different thickness to do their own topic-related sketches. In Design and Technology the children will practise skills needed for cooking as well as designing their own healthy dips and dippers before

evaluating them.

Music



During the first half term, the children will be working through the unit of 'Friendship Song'. They will learn the song and think about the meaning behind it. After half term, the children will 'Reflect, Rewind and Replay' which encompasses all the skills learned throughout the year.

Physical Education (PE)

During the term, the children will be developing their team working skills by focusing on small sided games. As the weather improves, the children will be working on their athletics skills. PE this term will be on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather and ensure they have a sun hat and a water bottle in school.



Religious Education (RE)



The time of Easter has just passed and this is an ideal opportunity to talk about the true meaning of Easter. Children will read and discuss the Easter story and what this means to Christians today. After half term, the children will discuss the celebration of Christmas and link this to The Big Freize panels of 'Incarnation' and 'Gospel'.

Personal Social & Health Education (PSHE)

The themes this term for Jigsaw are 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'. The children will be exploring feelings within the context of our important relationships including family and friends. In addition, the children will develop their ability to understand and manage the feelings associated with change. This will support the children with their transition to a new class in September.



French



During the term, the children will be following the Language Angels scheme which provides them with a linguistically rich and emotionally significant opportunity to speak a new language.
