Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome to Year 1! We are looking forward to having the children back in school and getting to know them better throughout Year 1. To **let us know that your child has read their book** and needs it changing you will need to write the book title and pages read (eg. P7-end) on the 'My Progress' sheet kept in a poly-pocket in their bookbag. You can also write any short comments about their reading in the space provided.

These will be checked on Mondays only. When we hear your child read in school this will be recorded on a different reading record. We will also use different books (of the same level) when we hear your child read to help keep everyone safe. As your child gets more confident in taking their own responsibility for books and safety, this system will change and develop. We will keep you updated as to how book change will continue if there are any changes.

Do keep up reading at home from Monday to Thursday by reading other books at home, e-books such as those on: https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/, practise tricky words, phonics sounds or blending using games on: https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/. This will be your child's main homework for the time-being. Also they can begin to practise their maths equations using 'Numbots'. Their personal login will be sent home and they can have a go at the games at home to practise their maths.
